
Safety & Health Conference 2022: "Revamp Towards Safety Transformation"



Introduction:

The Occupational Safety and Health (Amendment) Act 2022 which was gazetted on 16 March 2022, features significant amendments to the existing Occupational Safety and Health Act (OSHA) 1994. With the introduction of 27 new sections, the removal of 2 sections, the amendment of 35 existing sections, the repeal of the Factories and Machinery Act (FMA) 1967 and the integration of FMA provisions and OSHA into one comprehensive safety and health legislation, the major amendments in Occupational Safety and Health (Amendment) Act 2022 provide workers with better quality of safe and healthy environment.

The key amendments under the Occupational Safety and Health (Amendment) Act 2022 are, among others, amendments apply to all places of work; duty on principal to ensure the safety of contractors and sub-contractors; duty to conduct risk assessment; duty to develop and implement procedures to deal with emergencies; appointment of occupational safety and health coordinator; employees' right to 'remove' themselves from 'imminent danger' at the workplace; increased penalties and punishments for recalcitrant employers, self-employed persons, principals, and manufacturers; directors and office bearers jointly and severally liable; and many more......

- Provide updates on the latest legislations in Occupational Safety and Health (OSH);
- 2. Promote OSH culture at workplace;
- Promote prevention/ minimization of hazards, accidents and injuries at workplace towards safe working environment; and
- 4. Sharing of best practices in OSH.

 EN. AHMAD FUAD BIN JUSIN, is currently the Deputy Director (Operations), Department of Occupational Safety and Health (DOSH) Pulau Pinang. He plans and oversees the activities and operations of the regulatory enforcement and ensures that the implementation and compliance of Factories and Machinery Act 1967 and Occupational Safety and Health Act 1994 at workplace.

He joined Department of Occupational Safety and Health Malaysia (DOSH) since 1997 and his working experience in workplace safety and health involves inspection of construction site, chemical plants and other workplaces. He also involves and carries out investigations into occupational accidents, occupational diseases and other undesired events (such as dangerous occurrences and near miss/incidents) that could have led to personal injuries affecting workers or members of the public and also involved as prosecution officer.

He is also involved in the main committee in drafting the Occupational Safety and Health (Amendment) Act 2022. The Amendments to the existing Occupational Safety and Health Act 1994 (OSHA 1994) which focus on increasing the quality of safety, health and welfare of workers were passed on 27th October 2021 by the Malaysian parliament and were gazetted on 16th March 2022.

He has a Chemical Engineering degree from the University Technology Malaysia (UTM), as well as Master in Process Safety and Loss Prevention from the University Putra Malaysia (UPM).
